Application Questions

If you are completing your grant application using our online form, you might want to prepare some of your responses in advance of starting. Please note that the following is not a complete list of all questions on the form. You will still need to provide further information about your organisation, those involved in running it and membership information. You will also need to provide information about your organisation's finances, your budget and any permissions required to deliver your project.

However, the following questions require more detailed responses and some have character or word limits:

- What does your organisation do? (aims, key activities/services and beneficiaries) 250 words or 1500 characters limit
- What are you requesting funding for? You should summarise your project and be specific about what works, equipment or activities the grant would fund.
 300 words or 1800 characters limit
- Why is your project needed?
 300 words or 1800 characters limit
- What will the outcomes and benefits be for the community and residents of Blaby District?

300 words or 1800 characters limit

- How have you taken into account any environmental impacts of your project?
- Have you sought any other funding or support your project? Such as other grant
 applications, sponsorship from other organisations or businesses, support from local
 partner organisations, volunteers etc.
- How will you ensure that your project and organisation will be sustainable beyond the end of this funding? For example, please explain how you will fund the group/activity in the future or maintain a capital asset.
